FURTHER INFORMATION

ASK THE NATURALIST: An information table on various subjects surrounding Killbear’s ecology or history. Come by any time during the designated hours to learn from a Park Naturalist.

GUIDED HIKE: A 60–90-minute program that looks at different aspects of Killbear by foot. It is recommended that you wear proper footwear, bring water, sunscreen, and bug spray to these programs.

KIDS PROGRAM: An interactive program for children aged 5-12. Children must be accompanied by a guardian.

EVENING PROGRAM: A 45–60-minute presentation that is geared towards people of all ages.

The **DISCOVERY CENTRE** is open daily from 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM.

SNAKE TALK is provided every day at the Discovery Centre at 2:00pm, except on Wednesdays, when the snakes have just eaten.
