**CHILDREN'S PROGRAM**: A 45-60 minute program geared for children between the ages of 5-12 with their guardians.

**TEEN PROGRAM:** A 45-60 minute program geared for children between the ages of 10-15 with their guardians.

**GUIDED HIKE:** A 60-90 minute program that looks at different aspects of Killbear by foot. It is recommended that you wear proper footwear, bring water, sunscreen, and bug spray to these programs.

**EVENING PROGRAM:** A 45-60 minute presentation that is geared towards people of all ages.
