CHILDREN'S PROGRAM: A 45-60 minute program geared for children between the ages of 5-12 with their guardians.

TEEN PROGRAM: A 45-60 minute program geared for children between the ages of 10-15 with their guardians.

GUIDED HIKE: A 60-90 minute program that looks at different aspects of Killbear by foot. It is recommended that you wear proper footwear, bring water, sunscreen, and bug spray to these programs.

EVENING PROGRAM: A 45-60 minute presentation that is geared towards people of all ages.

Please be aware that pets are not permitted on programs.

The **VISITOR CENTRE**, is open daily from 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM. The Nature Shoppe, is open daily from **10:00 AM to 3:00 PM**. Meet Cynthia the foxsnake at our SNAKE TALK at 2:00 PM.
